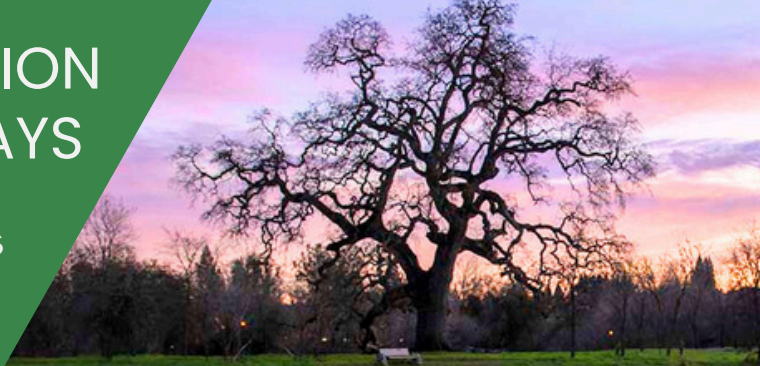

Priorities and Recommendations for Parks and Trail Improvements



PARKS AND RECREATION

(Short Term)

- Restore Maintenance Standards and Practices
- Upgrade Sports Field Irrigation/Drainage
- Renovate Joint-Use Facilities in Partnership with FCUSD
- Replace Synthetic Turf as needed
- Improve Sports Field Lighting
- Renovate: Courts (basketball, pickleball, tennis, volleyball)
- Renovate Aquatic Center Equipment/Amenities
- Replace Playgrounds, Picnic Areas (shade, tables, benches, drinking fountains as needed)

TRAILS AND PARKWAYS

(Short Term)

- Consistent Trail Maintenance Throughout the Growing System
- Pavement Rehabilitation (cracks, root lifts, eroding shoulders)
- Bridge Renovation (paint, wood decks, railings)
- Shoulder Renovation (vegetation clearance, re-grade shoulders)
- Provide Connection to Folsom Ranch
- Complete Unfinished Trail Connections

PARKS AND RECREATION

(Long Term + Tourism Enhancement)

- Finish Parks (Livermore, Davies, McFarland, etc.)
- Construct Parks (Benevento, Empire Ranch Sites #53 and #55, Legacy Park, etc.)
- Upgrade Rodeo Park Sports Fields
- Renovate Lembi Park
- Expand/Create Outdoor Tournament Facilities
- Expand/Create Indoor Recreation Facilities
- Strategic Zoo Exhibit Enhancements

TRAILS AND PARKWAYS

(Long Term + Tourism Enhancement)

- Wayfinding + Interpretive Information
- Folsom Blvd Overcrossing (connection to American River Parkway)
- Johnny Cash Trail Connection to Folsom Point/State Parks
- Trail Improvement Recommendations from the River District Master Plan
- El Dorado Trail Connection to Placerville
