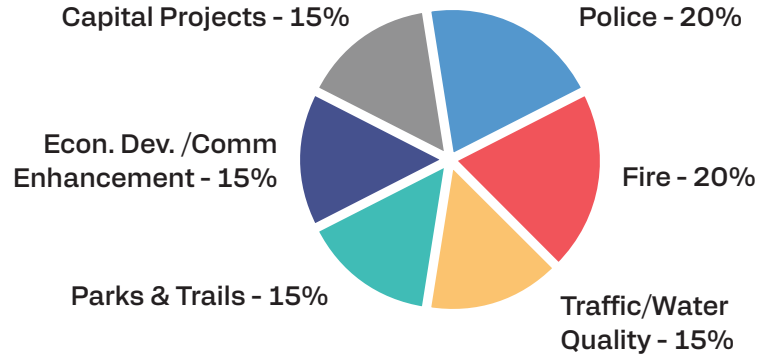
Join Folsom's Law Enforcement, Fire, Community Leaders, Small Business Owners and residents in Supporting Measure G.
